



Trinity Presbyterian Church Street Dream Scholarship Information

Intent

The Trinity Presbyterian Church Scholarship Committee is awarding scholarships through the Street Dream Endowment Fund to aid and assist students who desire to continue their education at the community college level. The scholarship is available to multiple applicants who desire to further their education and have been accepted by a community college accredited by the United State Department of Education and are Arizona residents. The scholarships are intended for either graduating high school students or adults wishing to seek a degree or certification including those returning to school. Preference will be given to those planning on entering public service careers, such as, but not limited to: daycare workers, nurses, eldercare workers and teachers. Financial need will be considered when awarding scholarships. The target GPA for high school transcripts is 2.0+.

Amount

Each scholarship awarded may be any amount up to \$2000 and will be paid directly to the chosen junior college. The scholarship is renewable, but applicants must reapply for consideration for funding for a second year. Colleges will return the full or prorated amount of the scholarship should the student fail to complete the course of study for which the scholarship was awarded.

Expectations

The Trinity Scholarship Committee reserves the right to expect and insist upon regular attendance at classes and maintaining a scholastic grade point average of 2.0+. Students should not be on disciplinary or academic probation. Future scholarships will be offered after confirmation of these criteria by an academic advisor.

Application Process

Applicants must submit a completed application (available at Trinity Presbyterian Church website), one-page essay addressing your academic goals and financial need and recommendations from two personal references to:
